Practice the Poem of the Week. Find all the sight words in the poem. Practice reading in a high pitch voice and a low pitch voice. Go on a letter hunt! Have someone hide letters around the house. When you find a letter, say the name and the letter sound.

Have a taste test. Find a new food. How does it look, smell, feel, and taste?
