<p>Mother's Day is on Sunday, May 10th. Do at least 1 nice thing for your mom every day this week (clean up your toys, make your bed, sing her a song, etc..). Take some time to make a nice card or picture for your mom and tell her why she is so special to you.</p> 	<p>Watch the book "The Gift of the Inukshuk" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zCi-V6uKsM</p> <p>Go outside and find rocks. See if you can stack them to build an Inukshuk. Which shapes stack the easiest? Can you make different sizes of inukshuks?</p> 	<p>Draw a picture about your favourite book. Include lots of detail. Make sure the picture shows the characters in the story and at least one of your favourite parts.</p>	<p>Play Sight Word Tic Tac Toe. Make a tic tac toe board on paper and print 1 sight word in each square. Take turns reading the word and try and get 3 in a row.</p> 
<p>Take a muffin tin outdoors and fill it with spring objects. Describe each item to someone in your family.</p> 	<p>Go for a walk and listen for birds. Do they make different noises? Can you describe the songs they make?</p> 	<p>Check out your food cupboards and see if you can find packages that are in the shape of a cylinder and a rectangular prism. Try and build a castle.</p> 	<p>Practice last weeks Poem of the Week called 3D Shapes. Can you describe some 3D shapes using the words: -Roll -Does not Roll -Stack -Does not stack -Slide -Does not slide -Points -No points <i>"A sphere can roll, it has no points and it can't be stacked."</i></p>

- Keep practicing your **sight words**.
- **Read!** Remember the 3 Ways to Read a Book – words, pictures, re-tell. You can Read to Self, Read to Someone or Listen to Reading. Check out some books on Raz-Kids.com. 😊
- **Writer's Workshop Home Edition** – Help write a grocery list or a favourite activities list. Don't forget to stretch out the sounds to help you spell tricky words.
- Keep working away on Math concepts with **Dreambox**
