Here at Gretna Green School, we have an amazing cafeteria run by a Board of Directors consisting of parent volunteers. Our cafeteria is a registered non-profit with any earnings returned to the school to assist in running Gretna Green School programs.

We have been in operation since 2016 and follow all provincial health and safety regulations. To operate our amazing cafeteria for our kids, we rely solely on the support of food purchases by our Gretna Green family as well as corporate and private donations.

What's on the Menu?

Each month, our chef creates a monthly menu which has a varied Daily Meal each day of the week. We also have a variety of regular Grab n'Go items which are available daily.

How Do I order?

Students can submit **Paper Order Forms** with exact change daily before 9AM. We know how busy our GG parents can be! With convenience in mind, we launched our **GG Foods Services Online Ordering System**. All GG families will register for the 2020-2021 school year.

GG Edible Playground

Healthy Foods for our GG kids is a top priority of GG Food Services.

In 2018 we launched our first GG Edible Playground, a community garden that exists because of community donations and volunteers. Our first harvest was able to provide fresh and healthy **seed to table** experiences for our GG kids.

We provided the GG Culinary classes with the opportunity to harvest vegetables. They in turn used their new skills to pickle and can the harvest with the proceeds of their hard work going towards important school activities. In early 2020, we were awarded a Federal grant which afforded us the opportunity to purchase a new large greenhouse for our Edible Playground. We are hopeful 2021 will provide us with the opportunity to move forward with our plans for the Edible Playground.
