Listen to my: "ill" video on my teacher page. Practice reading the 5 sentences. Then, read the same sentences on your sheet in your learning package. Sight Word Practice and Word Work (10 min)	Words of the week - Listen to my video : "Les mots fréquents " bébé où vu dix sous dessus

	Write the words on your rainbow sheet "Ça va bien aller" in your learning package. Use different colors for each letter of your word. You can also practice spelling these words the rest of the week by choosing an activity on the "Word Work Choice Board."
Speaking / Listening (5-10 min)	Practice singing the song : " Jouez au hockey". There is a web link to this song on my teacher page. The words to the song are in your learning package. Practice reading the words to your song. Read the booklet " C'est l'hiver. This will help with Winter vocabulary and sentence structures. This will also help with ideas for your writing activity. Color the pictures in the booklet.
Writing (10-15 min)	Write 1 sentence a day about Winter / Winter activities (3 sentences by the end of the week). Please refer to "L'hiver" vocabulary sheet in your learning package to help with ideas and spelling. You can also use the sight word (mots fréquents) sheet to help with spelling of words. Write your sentences on the writing sheet provided in your package. Illustrate each sentence. Example : En hiver, je patine. En hiver, il fait froid.
