

2014 MIRAMICHI POLICE FORCE STAIR CHALLENGE

On January 4th, 2013, the Miramichi Police hosted a stair challenge at the Headquarters of the Miramichi Police Force (MPFHQ). The challenge was to raise awareness towards the importance of officer wellness and ring in a few New Year's resolutions at the same time.

The challenge was to commemorate the 441 Emergency Services personal who died during the 9/11 attack on the World Trade Center. The twin towers were 110 stories each and the building at MPFHQ is 2 stories; meaning one twin tower was 55 times higher than police headquarters.

The cold temperatures didn't keep people away as 30 people ran and walked 55 trips around the police building to represent climbing up and down the twin towers.

In the process, the event raised \$530 for the Gretna Green Home and School Breakfast Program.
