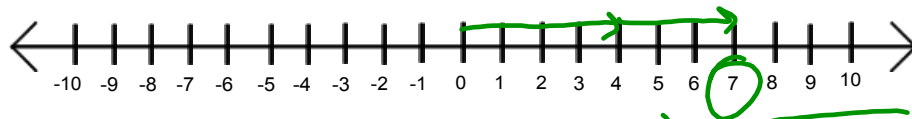

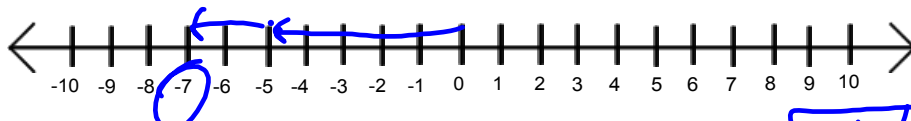

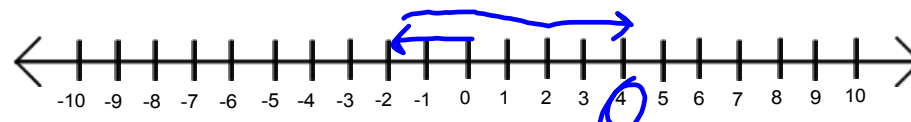
C)  $(-4) - (-1) = (-4) + 1 = -3$
