# Kindergarten Registration Week



Registration for children entering Kindergarten in September 2013 will be held from October 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> at your community school. Parents are reminded that Kindergarten attendance in 2013-2014 is compulsory for children born in 2008, except if a child is born between September 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> of that year. These children have the option of starting Kindergarten the following year. If you have a child entering

Kindergarten next year, please call the school at 778-6099 or visit the main office between 8:30 am-3:00 pm to have him or her registered. Proof of immunization, birth certificate and Medicare cards are required at the time of registration. It is important that your child be registered at this time in order to receive information needed for pre-school screening and successful transition into school for September 2013.
